The String Quartet No. 19 in C Major, KV. 465 by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart

Nicknamed "Dissonance" on account of its unusual slow introduction, is perhaps the most famous of Mozart's string quartets. It is the last in the set of six quartets composed between 1782-1785 that he dedicated to Joseph Haydn.

The String Quartet in A minor, Op. 132 by Ludwig van Beethoven

Famous for the slow third movement with the title, "*Heiliger Dankgesang eines Genesenen an die Gottheit, in der lydischen Tonart*" (A Convalescent's Holy Song of Thanksgiving to the Divinity, in the Lydian Mode)

The American String Quartet, Op. 96 in F major by Antonín Dvořák

Written in 1893 during Dvořák's visit to the United States this string quartet is one of the most popular in the chamber music repertoire and is influenced by American folk music.

The String Quartet No. 14 in D minor, known as *Death and the Maiden* by Franz Schubert

This string quartet is one of the pillars of the chamber music repertoire and is Schubert's testament to the terror and comfort of death.
